Visa	Student who are not Chinese citizens and who will study in China for
	over 6 months shall apply for X or student visa at Chinese embassies
	with admission notice, jw202 form and physical examination result.
	Those who will study for less than 6 months can also apply for F or
	visitor visa with the documents required by Chinese embassies.
	Since X, or student visa and L, or tourist visa have only 30 days of
	validity from the entry date to China, the holders must come to College
	for International Education in time for long term Residence Permit for
	Foreigner in the People's Republic of China. In addition, Students who
	live outside campus have to complete Residence Form of Temporary
	Residence at the police station of their community within 24 hours after
	entering China.
Insurance	Chinese government requires all international students purchase
